Emphasis will be placed on greater depth of the concepts in order to  
increase critical thinking skills. In addition, Honors will include more out  
of class reading, in-depth writing assignments, additional independent  
projects, and greater number of essay/short answer test questions.*

**ATHLETES** must pass a minimum of 3 credits in  
the semester prior to their sport's season to be  
eligible to play. A day/B day yearlong classes are  
considered 0.5 for each class.
