Note: What is the difference between Honors vs. Standard level classes?

Honors courses are more rigorous offerings of content than a standard course. A minimum grade of 80% in a prerequisite required.

Emphasis will be placed on greater depth of the concepts in order to increase critical thinking skills. In addition, Honors will include more out of class reading, in-depth writing assignments, additional independent projects, and greater number of essay/short answer test questions.
